

Machinery And Equipment Companies Endorse IOG Saltex As New Product Launchpad

A host of leading turfcare and open space machinery and equipment manufacturers and their agents will be using the IOG SALTEX show (5-7 September, Windsor Racecourse) to launch new products.

In addition to the show's exciting new Machinery Dealer Village - where dealers and distributors from all the major manufacturers of turfcare machinery and equipment will be able to display their wares – dozens of exhibitors throughout the showground will be announcing new product developments, reinforcing how IOG SALTEX continues to be THE annual launchpad for all the machinery and equipment needed by the modern grounds professional.

Here's a taste of the new products that visitors can expect to see during the three-day event:

The Ammann Yanmar SV15 mini excavator from Ammann Equipment; the S 10,000 green waste shredder on the Arbor Eater Brushwood Chippers stand; Bernhard & Co's new Rotomaster 4000 rotary blade grinder; and three new products from Bobcat - a turbo version of its ground-breaking Toolcat 5600 utility work machine, a new version of the T3571 telehandler and the 319 1.3 tonne mini-excavator.

BSS International will be launching the Wizard range of grass and fertiliser spreaders; Bunce (Ashbury) will be announcing new Noremat reach arm mowers and hedge cutters; Caterpillar/Finning UK will be showing its new C Series mini excavators and compact radius machines; and Chippers International will be launching a range of woodchippers and shredders transported on demountable tracked chassis with interchangeable attachments. New log splitters, ride-on tractors and a new scrub clearance rotor will be heading the display mounted by Cleartrack Plant & Machinery (CPM).

Among the turf and amenity trucks, personnel carriers and golf cars being shown by Club Car/Ingersoll Rand will be the new Carryall 232 petrol or electric rough terrain utility/turf truck.

And the Unimog Litter Picker, an innovative one-man system of automatically picking litter from roadside verges – allowing the grass to be cut and used for clean compost – will be making its debut on the Daimler-Chrysler UK Mercedes-Benz Unimog stand.

D J Turfcare Equipment will be announcing a trio of new products – the Surrey scarifier, Hambledon rake and brush, and the Atom domestic lawn edger – and

E P Barrus will be launching a new range of premium quality cylinder mowers, while Estesia will show the new 100 cm ultra-quiet Hydro 100 diesel high-lift, ride-on rotary.

Euromec will launch the AC 2000 compact sweeper; Gianni Ferrari's display will include the new Turbo Mowerdec mower; and new tracked mini dumpers, tracked aerial platforms and tracked mini excavators will be spearheading the Hinowa UK display.

On the Hydrema (UK) stand, the 900MPV Series 2 is an all-in-one telescopic loader, tool carrier, excavator and tractor; Kanga will be showing its new 7 Series multi-tasking skid steer loader; and Kersten UK will be announcing the K2000 SurfaceMaster sweeping machine. The new Eco Green screener will be displayed by King Feeders UK/Eco Green, as part of its show of composting equipment, shredders and screeners, and Lewis Equipment's display will include a new compact loader range with curved loader arms and parallel lift option.

Martin Lishman will be launching new Midi-Spray skid unit compact sprayers for use on utility vehicles; Massey Ferguson will display the new Dyna transmission option for MF 1500 Series compact tractors; and included in the range of unmanned robotic mowing equipment being shown by McMurtry will be the new MAS 03 GPS guided mower for large areas.

Meade Machines will be displaying a new 60 kg kerb lifter; Quadzilla will have the new 500E 4x4 utility ATV; and Red Rhino Crushers will display its new 4017t Micro Crusher which, it says, represents a significant advance in the onsite recycling of waste hardcore and rubble.

A new scarifier will complement the value-for-money Protea mowers available from Rivendell Projects; Rototrench will be launching the RWT 100 rotary wheel trencher; and included in the comprehensive range of tools and equipment being shown by Sayell Equipment will be the new Electrocoup electronic secateurs, with and without extension poles.

Taylor Construction Plant will be showing its new 2006 Hi-T500 mini dumper, which features significantly reduced noise and hand/arm vibration; Terrain Aeration will show the new Side Tracker and Airforce Tracker 2; and Timberwolf's display will include the new 45 HP turbo-charged green waste shredder and a 90 HP 10 inch woodchipper on a twin-axle 3600 chassis.

New stumpcutters from Rayco and shredders from Saelen will be on the Westcon Equipment (UK) stand; Trilo will have the new Green Clipper Sport 4 m

electric mower; and among the range of aeration and ground maintenance, grass cutting and material collection machinery being shown by Wiedenmann UK will be the new front-mounted winter maintenance machines including snow blades and gritting machines, as well as dust/dirt maintenance machines.

Finally, Wood-Mizer UK will be showing two portable sawmills: the LT20 mobile unit and the revolutionary LT15 static model which, with 10 HP diesel engine, costs from just £3,995.
