Playground markings – expression of interest**

The Football Foundation, as part of their grant aid programme, is seeking to identify specialist companies who can supply a complete range of pre formed hot applied thermoplastic markings in accordance with the Primary Playgrounds 4 Sports Guidance Brochure found at:

Companies will be required to meet selection criteria that will include:

- The proven ability to supply a full range of pre formed hot applied thermoplastic markings that should comply with BS 3262 Part 1 and be applied in accordance with BS 3262 Part 3.

- All markings must be slip resistant and when tested in accordance with ITF CS 02/01, the dry and wet slip resistance should be in the range 60 to 110. Wet test areas should be produced using the procedure described in BS 7044 Part 4.
