Level 2 IOG Technical Awards in Turf Surface Maintenance

Course description

There are 5 Awards which can be taken stand alone or gradually built-up to make Level 2 Technical Certificate in Turf Surface Maintenance. Each Award lasts a maximum of 4-months from the date of enrolment.

Why

These qualifications are ideal for someone wishing to develop specific areas of their knowledge and understanding. They are also ideal for those who wish to re-engage with a formal learning experience but do not wish to attend college.

Requirements

There are no formal entry requirements for each course, although you should have a keen interest in sports and sports turf maintenance. Candidates should ideally have a minimum of 1 years' experience to gain the most from a course.

Study

Each course will be studied through distance / home study learning, with tutor support by email. A detailed syllabus and course study plan is provided along with specific web links which signpost relevant material.

Assessment

Each qualification (award) is assessed by sitting one 45 minute written examination paper.

Level 2 IOG Technical Certificate in Turf Surface Maintenance

Course description

The estimated time for study is 180 hours, lasting 11-months (maximum) from the date of enrolment. If you wish to focus on a specific part of this course we have 5 separate Level 2 Awards - ideal for those who have attended an IOG training course and who wish to learn and understand more on a particular subject.

Why

This qualification is ideal for an experienced grounds person someone wishing to gain an initial formal qualification in turf maintenance, but who do not wish to attend a traditional college. No practical work involved with this qualification.

Requirements

There are no formal entry requirements for this course, although you should have a keen interest in turf maintenance. Candidates should ideally have a minimum of one years experience to gain the most from the course.

Study

Each course will be through distance / home study learning, with tutor support by email. A detailed syllabus and course study plan is provided (no text books are provided) along with specific web links which signpost relevant material.

Assessment

The qualification is assessed by sitting two 1½ hour written examination papers.

Level 3 IOG Supervisory Management

Course description

The five modules – team motivation, coaching skills, idea generation, meeting management and team building – can be studied individually for the IOG Level 3 Certificate in Supervisory Management, or as a whole for the full qualification. Why

Requirements

Study

Extending across nine months, learn at a pace that suits the individual and is based on distance/home study learning, with tutor support by email. Totalling around 150 hours of learning – enrol on one or more modules to suit your needs.

Assessment

Gain a certificate of Module Achievement, in addition to the certificate of Module Completion (which does not require an assessment element), by passing the end of module online multiple choice assessment. Learners who study and complete all 5 modules will achieve a qualification in 'IOG Level 3 Certificate in Supervisory Management'.

Requirements

Level 4 IOG Certificate in Sustainable Turf Management

Course description

There is no practical work involved.

Level 4 IOG Professional Cert in Turf Surface Management
